STEM-which stands for Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths is a strategy to promote higher order skills such as, innovation, creativity and entrepreneurship. For students in Years 3 and 5, Term 2 is NAPLAN time. Testing Week commences on Tuesday, 15 May and concludes on Thursday, 17 May. Friday will be used as a “catch up” day for any students who miss any of the tests. NAPLAN is a routine test and is helpful in

validating the other assessments that teachers make. We use NAPLAN results to help guide our decision making-it helped identify Talk for Writing and iMaths as suitable programs for Eddystone PS.
