We Are Listening

In the past 15 months, we've been asking the question and seeking feedback from parents — we're listening! Over the coming months, we'll broadcast information about how we're changing some things that have been done in the past but have not been getting parents attention. We know we can do things differently because you tell us when we ask and so it's in that spirit that we continue to evolve and improve.

Reporting To Parents

A change in the way we have done things. Firstly, all student reports will be emailed home (we trialled this process last year with tremendous success). Reports will arrive in your inbox on Thursday, 21 June — much earlier than in previous years. **You can help us by making sure that we have a correct email address for you.** Our system provides us with a report when you open your child's report so we know that it has arrived.

In previous years, 3 Way Conferences have been held before you get your child's report—this year, 3 Way Conferences will be held on Wednesday, 27 June. This is a week after

you receive reports. We've listened! Parents have told us that to be better prepared for Conferences, it is better to have had reports with time to digest the information. **So again, you can help us by opening and reading your child's report before 3 Way Conference Day.**

3 Way Conferences

This year, 3 Way Conferences will be more of an "interview" style where the focus will be on each child's strengths, areas to improve and how teachers, parents and students can best address these focus area. Each teacher will be well prepared with individualised student data to share and discuss during the time parents and students have with their teachers. I am asking teachers to prepare quality and helpful information for each student and their parents. **Please help your child by taking the opportunity to attend your 3 Way Conference/Interview.**
