All parents are invited to attend our annual Learning Journey Evening.

This is an opportunity for parents to view and talk with the children about the work that they have been engaged in so far this year. Everything is up for discussion - examples of Talk for Writing, Maths, Reading, Visible Learning and Dispositions - it's all on the table to have discussions about with your children.

Look at the classroom displays; ask your children what they are about and what they learned. Ask them what their learning intentions were?
