Eddystone's Community 1 plus 2 club aims to...

- A. Develop a community learning environment where parents and staff are involved in providing a range of learning experiences to enhance all children's development in language and social interaction
- B. Allows for any easy transition into Kindy



- C. Develop parent knowledge and participation in their child's school life. Ensuring that the parents are familiar with the learning environment, staff and the wider school community
- D. Allow the children to have exposure to a variety of experiences, which will focus on literacy, numeracy and social skills. We will also encourage the development of habits to inspire children and parents to have an active lifestyle that includes a combination of indoor and outdoor play
- E. We aim to provide a variety of community speakers to come and share information with you on nutrition, school nurse, etc. We aim for these sessions to be informative and allow for opportunities for early intervention
- F. Most importantly have fun, make new friends and enjoy the time with your child.

The 1 plus 2 club will be held every Thursday morning from 9am to 11am.

Please come to the Kindy classroom.

These sessions will only be held during school term times.

Please supply all items that your child will require, HAT, change of clothes, drink bottle and a piece of fruit to share. We also ask that each family provide a gold coin donation that will be used to cover the cost of consumables that we will use during the year.



Please come along and meet other parents and children. You will be required to help your child with the activities of the day, guiding them to participate in all activities and encouraging him/her to interact with other children. If you need assistance please feel free to ask a staff member. You are asked to supervise your own child at all times.

Each week as you arrive can you please sign the attendance register that will be at the front door next to the fruit basket and gold coin donation box.

We will have a parent roster available each week and I would appreciate your help.

I ask that each parent does a different job each week.
